



The group podcast was kind of crazy, but I also kind of loved it. It was difficult to get everyone involved on such a last 3 minute basis, I don't think people planned on having to make the time for such an intensive, short project. I would be a good idea to emphasize the importance of setting time aside to work on it weeks prior so that everyone has space carved out to work on it, whether that be as a group or independently.

- <sup>5</sup> I think that it would be great to have weekly podcast assignments and that those podcasts could also be recommended by students.
- <sup>6</sup> I realize that this is the first year the class has been bigger. Though having gone through it, I think a smaller class size would for sure be helpful more intimate, for support and feedback :)

Fewer students and more reasonable deadlines, ie. assignment in the first week was really too fast, and not enough
time for the group project. I appreciated the incorporation of a group multiplier. Also, Duncan seems great, but maybe too formal or distant, and so it's hard to really get excited. I found his teaching style somewhat disempowering.
